- Career Management

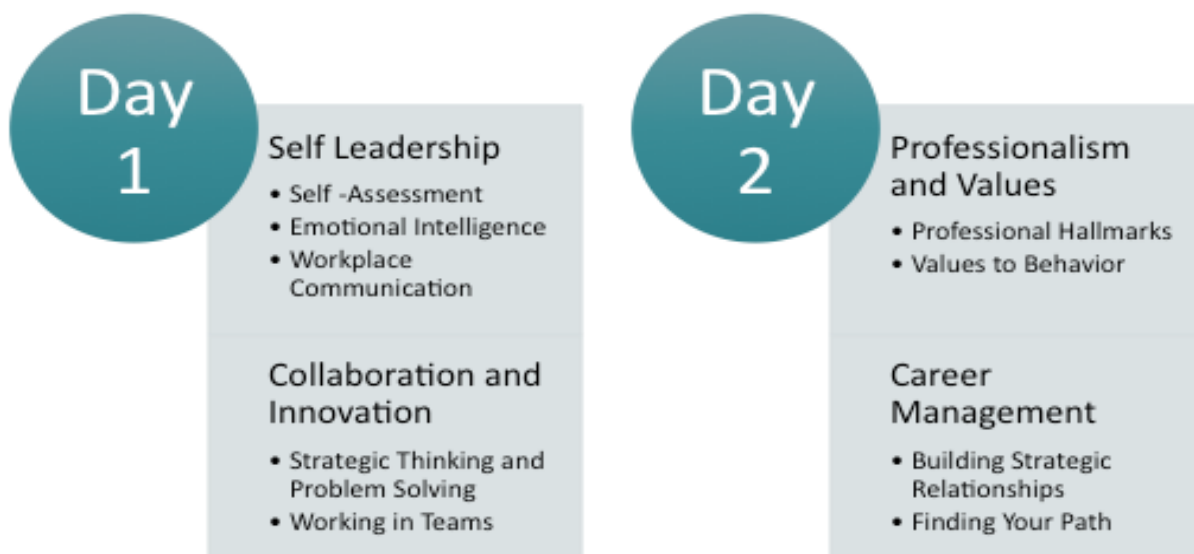
Students leave their C2C experience with professional competence and confidence; ready to distinguish themselves in whichever professional arena they choose.

Self-Assessment

Students begin the program by taking the NBI Assessment online. The NBI provides powerful insight into how our brain's natural preferences for taking in and processing data impacts how we interact with others. The NBI is used as a common thread throughout the program, as students reflect on the various ways they approach challenges and work with others.

Training
